SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR VISITORS

Welcome to the *Az Marine* premises! Please take the opportunity and time to read and understand the Yard's Safety and Security requirements and information in these guidelines.

1. HSE Policy

To protect and preserve the environment, and to ensure the safety and health of its Members of the Workforce, by providing a place of employment that is, as much as possible, free from recognized hazards that have the potential to cause physical harm to workers

2. PERSONAL SAFETY

- ❖ As a visitor of Az Marine yard's premises, you are responsible for your actions.
- ❖ Always seek advice and consult safety Officer when in doubt.
- ❖ Be responsible and do your part to keep Az Marine a safe and healthy work place.
- ❖ All visitors entering the shipyard must first report to the Security Guardhouse and will be issued with a "VISITOR PASS". The "VISITOR PASS" must be prominently displayed at all times during your presence in the yard.

3. PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT



Hard Hats

Approved hard hats in good condition are required to be worn at all times on board and in all areas of the yard.

Cover / Safety Shoes

Full covered shoes which is impermeable (no holes) shall be worn in all area of the yard.

Other PPE may be required (eg. Safety Glass, Ear plugs, Safety Gloves) depending on your activity.

4. PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY

All visitors walking in the yard premises shall use pedestrian walkway that has been designated and painted accordingly in yellow colour as shown and to use designated "zebra" for crossing the road as part of traffic safety.

5. BARRICADES

Areas within the yard premises which pose a threat to personnel safety & health area marked with red & white hazard identification tape to increase awareness that the area should not be entered.

6. "NO SMOKING" POLICY IN THE YARD PERMISES

Az Marine adopts a mandatory "NO SMOKING" policy for all Personnel. Cigarettes and lighters are strictly prohibited in the operational zones due to fire safety reasons. Designated smoking area only allowed.



7. GANGWAY



- ❖ All vessels are provided with gangway for safe access.
- ❖ At the gangway entrance life jacket is provided for use.
- ❖ All visitors going onboard the vessel should be accompanied by yard personnel or ship crew.

8. REPORTING AND HANDLING OF EMERGENCY

Upon discovery and reporting outbreak of a fire or an emergency, the person shall raise the alarm and shall immediately alert all personnel in the vicinity and office room via. "Break glass" call points, or by radio equipment **VHF 09** to inform the Safety Officer.

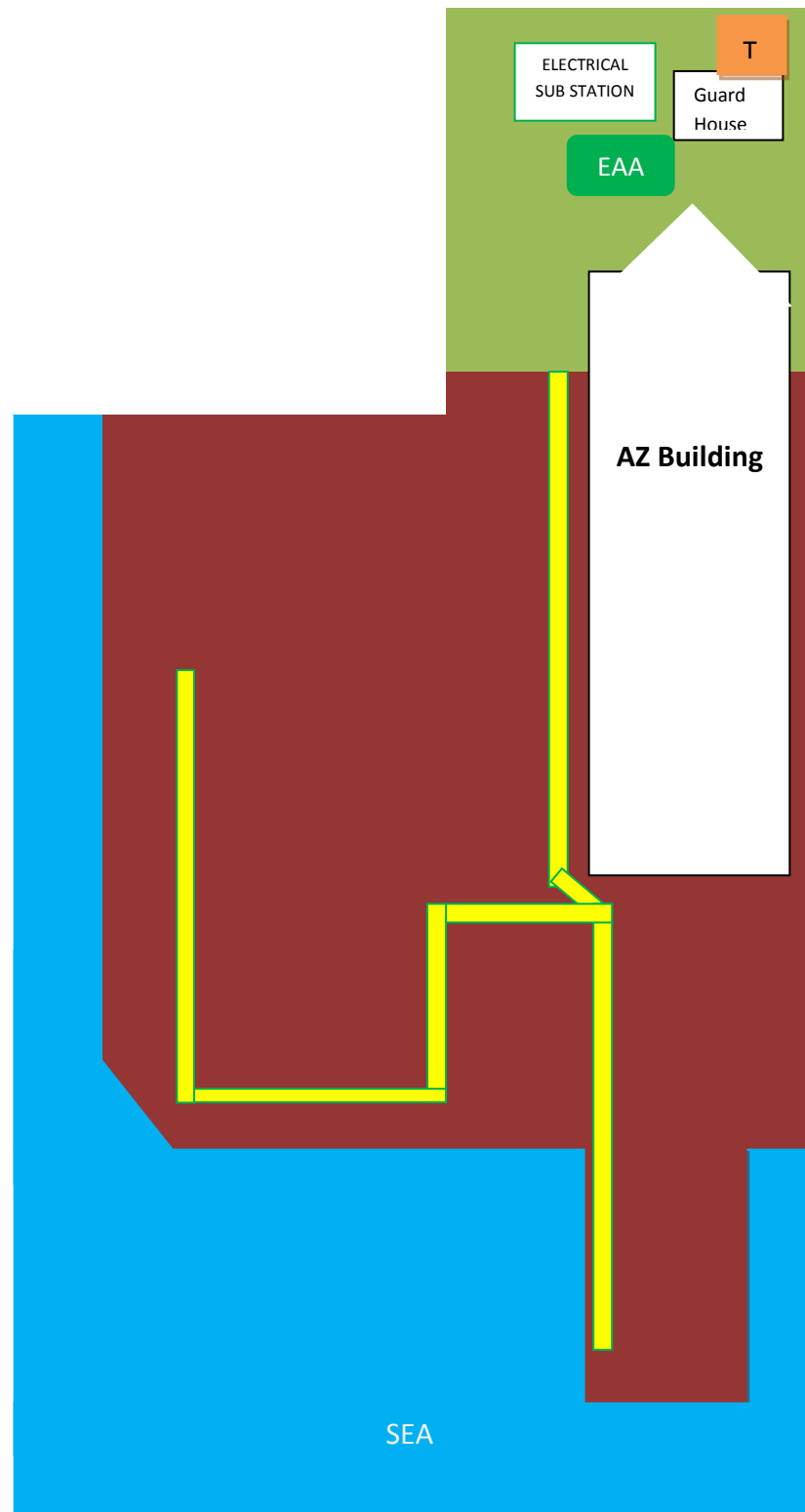
- Go directly to the designated evacuation assembly area (as instructed):
 - *As applicable, stay with your Host.*
- Do not re-enter the building until authorized to do so by emergency response personnel.
